SECTION 33.

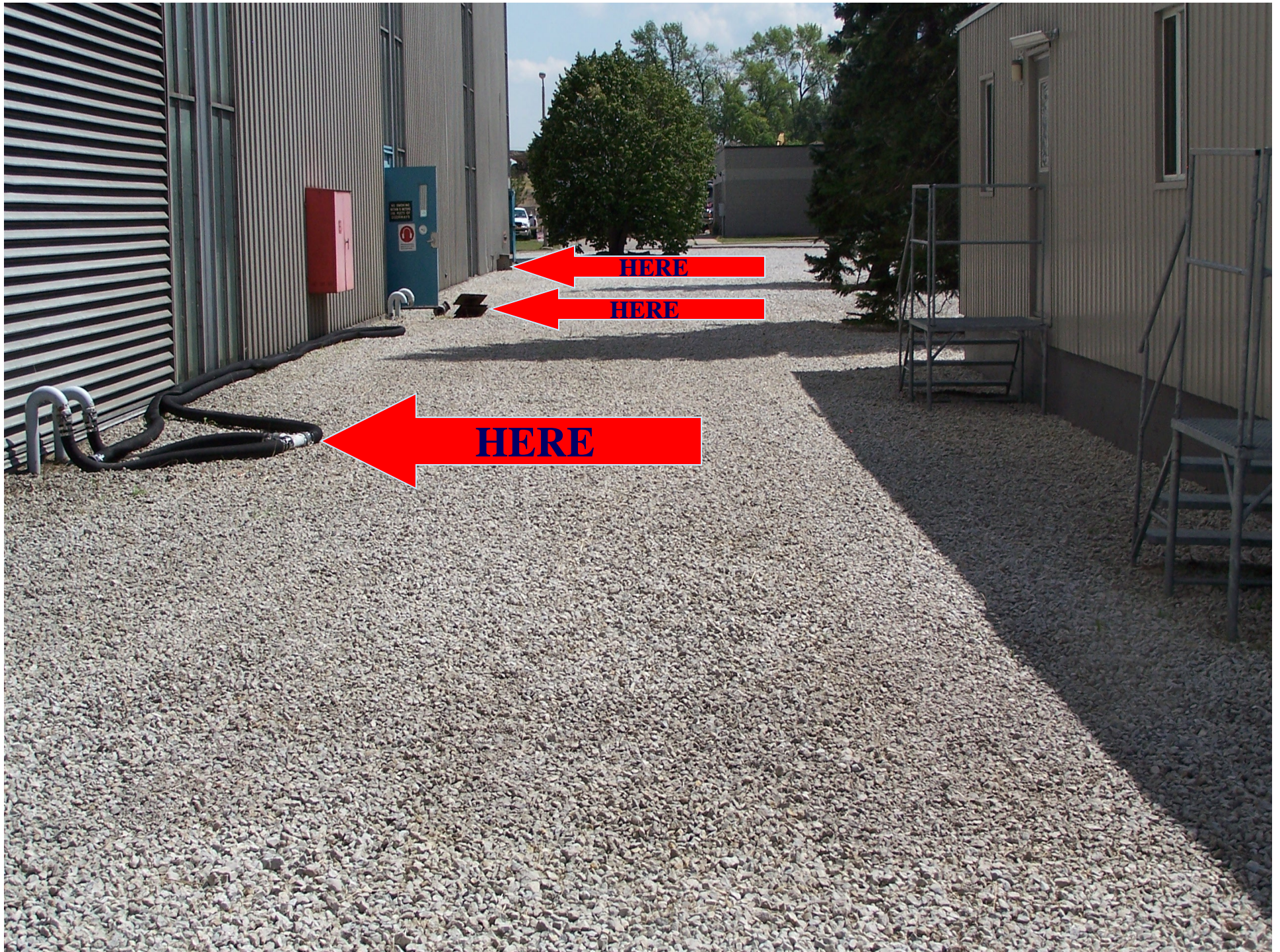
- (1) A work surface shall be kept free of ,
